Introduction – Objective of the Project

CHILDLINE India Foundation (CIF) is the nodal agency of the Union Ministry of Women and Child Development acting as the parent organization for sitting up, managing and monitoring the CHILDLINE 1098 services all over the country.

CHILDLINE 1098 services is a 24 hours free emergency phone outreach service for children in need of care and protection. Initiated in 1996 as a pilot project in Mumbai, CHILDLINE is currently operational in 412 cities across 35 states. The collaboration between CIF and PRAVA started during the year -2015 in Gajapati, Odisha

This is a project supported by the **Union Ministry of Women and Child Development** and linking state Government, NGOs, bilateral / multilateral agencies and corporate sectors.

Vision: A child -friendly Nation that guarantees the rights and protection of all children. CIF also functions as a National Center for awareness, advocacy and training on issues related to child protection.

Adopt Gajapati – Green gajapati

Concept Note:

Adopt Gajapati is a noble and a sustainable development thought evolved from the thought of Adopt India. The thought is evolved in the minds of young and dynamic software engineers of Gajapati district who are having concern about the society.

A Team of software engineers working throughout the country of Gajapati district have come forward to serve the mother land Gajapati district (Paralakhemundi) as a token of social responsibility to the mother land. They feel it as one of the important responsibility to work/serve for the mother land.

Proposed Interventions:

- Green Gajapati: To make Gajapati Green through promoting plantation and keep ecological balance.
- Swachha Gajapati: To maintain sanitation and hygienic condition in Gajapati.
- Sujala Gajapati: Promotion and protection of water resources, promote effective management and proper use of water.
- Cultural Gajapati : Promotion and protection of social –cultural heritage of Gajapati

Green / Swachha Gajapati:

The Green Gajapati is aimed at making the Gajapati green through plantation at different areas with different institution clubbing with Swachha Bharat Abhiyan. It is planned to take up of these activities in education institutions where the children/ students will be aware on Swachha Bharat and Environment protection. In turn they will take care of the plantation in the schools/colleges simultaneously they will also take of Swachha Bharat program on their own. The objective to build an attitude among the students toward the environment and to work for ecological balance in the long run this approach will have an impact on the other stake holder/communities in the district on plantation and environment promotion.

- Project period – 3 years i.e 2017-20
- Target Area – Schools, colleges and other institutions of Paralakhemundi town the district Gajapati.

During the present proposed project period of 3years the 2 themes i.e. Green Gajapati and Swachha Bharat Abhiyan will be implemented and other 2 themes in the coming near future.

Goal:

A pleasant and healthy environment in Gajapati.

Objectives:

- To promote plantation in 15 educational and other institutions of Gajapati by the end of Nov.2020.
- To maintain sanitation and hygienic environment in the 15 educational institutions by the end of Mar 2020.

Strategies:

- Inclusion of all the stake holders in the programme I.e Education Dept Forest Dept. Horticulture Dept. Student, NGO and Civil societies.
- The role of students is a centric point in the programme.
- Voluntary action is main Focus.
- Gender equity – equal participation of both Male and Female.
- Transparency will be maintained at all the levels of the project implementation.

Activities:

- Plantation in 15 Educational institutions.
- Swachha Bharat Abhiyan in 15 Educational institutions.
 - 1st Year – 5 Educational Institutions.
 - 2nd Year – 5 Educational Institutions.
 - 3rd Year – 5 Educational Institutions.

Project implementing Agency (PIA):

The project will be implemented by a NGO called “PRAVA” working since last 20 Years in Gajapati district under the leadership of experienced and committed persons from different disciplines.
